



# 3M eBooks on Blackberry

OS 10.2.1 or later

\*\* There is no 3M app available for Blackberry. However, you can access the 3M app through the Amazon app store if you are running an operating system of **10.2.1 or later**. You will need to create an Amazon account.

## Installation and Set Up

### **Step 1: Download the Amazon App Store**

1. Go to <http://amazon.com/getappstore>
2. Click the yellow button to “download amazon app store”
3. In the top right, tap “save”
4. You will be redirected to your downloads. Click on the app to open.
5. In the upper right, tap “install” then “accept”
6. Tap “open” in upper right, then “continue”
7. Enter your amazon account info or tap to “create an account”



### **Step 2: Download the 3M App via Amazon**

1. Click the search icon in the upper right
2. Search for “3M cloud library.” The app will appear in the search results
3. Tap “free” then “free” again, then “get app,” then “install”
4. Tap “accept” then “open”



### **Step 3: Log in**

A welcome screen will appear when you open the app for the first time. Follow these steps to log in and get started:

1. Select the country, province, and Guelph Public Library
2. Enter your GPL card number and PIN
3. Tap “end user license agreement” and tap “agree”
4. Tap “login”

## Borrowing eBooks

1. Browse for an eBook and select one you wish to read.  
(See searching tips on the reverse of this page)
2. When you tap on a book cover, the book’s details page will show containing a green checkout button (or a hold button if the book is already signed out)
3. Tap the checkout button, and the app will redirect to the My Books section. The book will begin downloading in the Currently Reading wood-paneled area.
4. Tap the book to open.

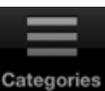


### Other Helpful Information:

- To receive email notifications for your holds, go to “My Books” and select “Account Profile.” Tap “Email notifications” and enter your email address.
- Checkout limit of 5 eBooks; loan period is 21 days
- Up to 30 eBooks may be placed on hold at a time; held for 3 days once available
- No renewals, but books can be checked out again if there are no holds

### Searching for eBooks:

Within the app there are four main tabs across the top of the screen with multiple ways of accessing GPL’s 3M eBook collection:

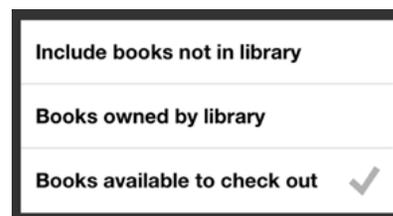
	Displays GPL’s currently featured collections
	Browse by subject or genre
	Search for an eBook. Best for looking up a specific title or author
	Where you will go to read books that you have checked out, as well as find your holds, account profile, messages, and reading history.

When using the Categories or Search options, you can filter your results to show only books that are currently available to check out.

Under Categories, click 



Then choose “Books available to check out”



Under Search, click 

### Returning eBooks:

eBooks will automatically expire after 21 days, but if you wish to return an eBook early, follow these steps:

1. Go to My Books and tap “list view” in upper right corner
2. Tap the book you want to return
3. Tap the red check in button, then confirm “return book”
4. To return to the My Books screen, tap the  button in the lower left corner
